Is pricing an indicator of the quality of stone restoration services?

Q. How do I know if the higher priced contractor is ripping me off or if the lower priced one knows what he is doing?

A. Ask the higher priced stone restoration contractor why the price is higher. The contractor should be able to justify the reason for the price in a logical way and help you understand the processes needed to do the job right. Similarly, ask the lower priced contractor why the price is so low. The idea here is to gather enough information to determine whether you are dealing with a contractor who cuts corners to make a bigger profit or a contractor who will get the job done right and offer competitive, fair prices.
