


**We have a pink marble tile that has some brown veins and the veins are soft and coming out. Is there anything we can do to stop these veins from softening?**



The material you are describing is probably a marble known as rossa perlinio. This type of marble, when it is formed has mud running through it and this is what the soft veins are---mud. Unfortunately the only cure is to fill the veins as they erode out.

**TIP** These veins can be filled with polyester or if you have a lot of veining you can use a colored unsanded grout.
