

How should I advise my customers to remove the soap scum off their marble and tile shower walls?

Several products are available at the grocery store for removing soap scum, but they most likely are not safe for natural stone. Most soap scum removers contain acids which should not be used on marble surfaces. These cleaners work well on ceramic tile surfaces and are safe to use on them, but for marble and other stones the very best product available for this is Stonecare PRO Signature's Heavy Duty Soap Film Remover.

TIP To help keep soap scum from forming on the shower walls, apply a good quality impregnator and an application of Stonecare PRO Signature's Marble Conditioning Treatment.
