My customer has asked "How do I clean around the fixtures on my marble vanity top?" What should I tell them?

This has always presented a problem. If the marble adjacent to the fixtures is severely pitted, I would recommend hiring a plumber to remove the fixtures and then hire you to refinish the vanity. Once the marble has been refinished, let them know to use a neutral cleaner to clean around the fixtures. Avoid build-up of soap by cleaning behind and around the fixtures daily. If soap scum accumulates anyway, recommend Stonecare PRO Signature Heavy Duty Soap Film Remover. Remind them to be sure to read the labels carefully, and to avoid acid products, since these could tarnish the metal fixtures.
