How do a properly clean and polish marble floors?

Q. I own a janitorial company. Can you walk me through a marble floor cleaning job of 1,100 sq.ft. using your products. I will purchase everything needed for the work from you.

A. There is no simple answer for this question. For routine cleaning of a marble floor, you will want to use a quality neutral cleaner designated safe for natural stone, such as MB-1.

However, your question did not specify the condition of the floor. Is it dull, scratched, etched? If so, cleaning is not the answer. Is it particularly dirty, stained, or otherwise requiring more specialized maintenance? You may want to find a stone and tile restoration <u>PRO here</u>.
